Dr. Angeline Yong is currently medical director and consultant dermatologist at Angeline Yong Dermatology, Gleneagles Medical Centre, Singapore; and is also visiting consultant dermatologist at Thomson Medical Centre. She graduated from the National University of Singapore where she was awarded both the Eli-Lily Gold Medal and the Class of 1975 book prize.

Dr Yong then completed her specialist training as a dermatologist at the National Skin Centre (NSC), and was awarded a year-long Health Manpower Development Plan Fellowship at the St John's Institute of Dermatology, London, where she trained in Mohs Microscopic Surgery and cutaneous reconstruction, alongside other dermatologic surgery and laser procedures. She later completed a second fellowship at Mount Sinai Hospital, New York, where she underwent further training in hair transplantation, cosmetic and procedural dermatology.

Her areas of subspecialty interests are in dermatological and laser surgery, cosmetic dermatology, skin cancers, Mohs Micrographic Surgery, hair and nail disorders, and hair transplant surgery. Prior to her leaving for private practice, Dr Yong was the founding consultant and lead for the Hair Transplantation Service at NSC.

Dr Yong also holds a Master of Public Health with Harvard University and is both an avid educator and key opinion leader in the cosmetic and laser dermatology fields. Her areas of research include dermatological surgery and lasers, cosmetic dermatology, and hair disorders.
