Roy Chan is Senior Consultant and Medical Advisor in the National Skin Centre, where he was Director from 2004 to 2014; he is Senior Advisor to the National Healthcare Group. He was inaugural Chairman of the Chapter of Dermatologists, Academy of Medicine, and inaugural Executive Director (Clinical) of the Skin Research Institute of Singapore.

His clinical interests include STI, HIV, cutaneous infections and diseases of hair. He has long standing research and programmatic experience in public health and disease prevention. He is Head of the National STI Control Programme and member of National HIV Committees for over 20 years.

He has been actively involved in training programmes for students and dermatology residents. His other appointments include Clinical Professor at NUS YLL School of Medicine, Adjunct Professor in NTU-Imperial College LKC School of Medicine, and Adjunct Professor in NUS SSH School of Public Health.

Among his awards are the Queen Elizabeth II Gold Medal by Royal Society for Public Health, and the Ministry of Health National Medical Excellence Award Clinician. He is recipient of the ILDS Certificate of Appreciation and a Honorary International Fellow of the American Dermatology Association.

He founded Action for AIDS in 1989, a non-governmental organisation that focuses on care, support, prevention and advocacy. It was awarded the Dr Lee Jong-Wook Memorial Prize in Public Health by the World Health Organisation in 2010.
