Dr Tan Suat Hoon is the Director of National Skin Centre (NSC) Singapore since April 2014. NSC is the major tertiary dermatological centre in Singapore with comprehensive subspecialty expertise, mostly led by multidisciplinary teams, and is the national centre for education and research in dermatology.

Dr Tan received her post-graduate training in dermatology at NSC and specialized in dermatopathology, when she completed a fellowship with Dr Philip McKee in 1993 – 1994 in the UK. She was the Chairman of the Chapter of Dermatologists of the College of Physicians from 2009 to 2013 and currently chairs the national Residency Advisory Committee for Dermatology since 2015. She is Adjunct Professor with the Lee Kong Chian School of Medicine, Nanyang Technological University/Imperial College London and also holds academic appointments at the Yong Loo Lin School of Medicine, National University of Singapore and the Duke-NUS Graduate Medical School Singapore.

Dr Tan's subspecialty interests and expertise are in cutaneous lymphomas and dermatopathology. She is a firm advocate of education and research and has mentored many dermatology trainees who are now well-established dermatologists in their fields.
